The summer show has been going for only half that time and has involved a fair bit of experimentation in what we perform, a considerable amount of the material to date having been originated within the club.

CTC is a registered charity and as such we retain enough funds to produce the next years shows, what remains is ploughed back into the community; either by donations to other local organisations, to training club members in theatre skills or to enhancing stage and technical facilities at the village hall with the aim of improving our production quality.

Those of you who were present at our first production will no doubt remember the single scene plastic painted tarpaulin, the makeshift lighting system and the absolutely no sound system. We have come a long way since then, and what you see and hear round you tonight has only been made possible by your patronage. We still have a large number of improvements we want to make, all aimed at improving the quality of what you eventually see and hear.

Every year we undertake a cabaret/dinner night in conjunction with the village hall, this year we are doing a second cabaret night in September so keep an eye open for the adverts.

We also hope to extend our programme schedule in 2005 by undertaking a full length comedy play in the spring. All of this requires one essential ingredient, NO it's not money, its TALENT, particularly adult talent. We know it exists out there in our community, so if you have a desire to tread the boards or, just as importantly, work behind the scenes, we would like to hear from you.
